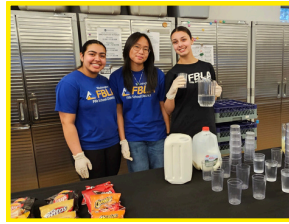

NEW MVCC OFFERINGS

After-School Drop-In Center: April 13-June 17

Students in grades 1–12 are invited to spend their Monday and Wednesday afternoons at MVCC enjoying a safe space filled with homework help, hands-on activities, crafts, games, and more.

Taco Tuesday & Karaoke: May 5

A family-friendly event hosted by our "Lovely Lunch Ladies." For just \$10 per person, you'll enjoy delicious tacos, refreshing *mocktails, *desserts, all while singing your favorite karaoke songs (*additional cost).

Theater Camp: July 20-24 & July 27-31

Youth in grades 3-9 are invited to join MVCC for a two-week Theater Camp. During this introduction to theater, campers will learn the basics of being on stage, play theater games, and participate in a performance.

OUR IMPACT

MVCC distributed 9,424 food packs and 1,360 soup kits, served 5,379 community dinners, and supported over 300 students. Programs included 1,000+ backpacks, 99 youth in summer camp, 219 senior fitness classes (6,043 attendances), and 14 family events reaching 1,765 participants. Thank you!
